The following are guidelines that are recommended for patients with co-existing medical conditions.

<input type="checkbox"/> BMP	Hypertension, Cardiac/Pulmonary disease, Diabetes, Renal disease, Malignancy, Taking medications such as: Diuretics, Digoxin, or any drug-induced electrolyte abnormalities
<input type="checkbox"/> CMP	Liver Disease, Malignancy
<input type="checkbox"/> CBC <input type="checkbox"/> w/ Diff	Anemia, Hemorrhagic disease, Liver disease, Malignancy, EBL (estimated blood loss) >200mL
<input type="checkbox"/> PT/PTT/INR	Bleeding disorder, Liver disease, Anticoagulant therapy
<input type="checkbox"/> UA <input type="checkbox"/> w/ C&S	Symptomatic patient
<input type="checkbox"/> HCG	Menstruating females and those within 1 year of menopause
<input type="checkbox"/> T & S	Required for patient undergoing Termination of Pregnancy or Missed Abortion
<input type="checkbox"/> EKG	Hypertension, Diabetes, Stroke, Cardiac/Vascular/Pulmonary/Renal conditions, or Invasive Surgery
<input type="checkbox"/> Chest X-Ray	COPD, Cardiac disease, New onset respiratory symptoms, Chronic smoking > 10 pack years

- History and Physical is valid **within 30 days** of surgery.
- Laboratory testing is valid **within 60 days** of surgery and must be performed by CLIA (Clinical Laboratory Improvement Act) approved laboratory. Type and screen is valid **within 72 hours** of surgery.
- In the absence of recent medical problems, chest x-ray is valid **within 1 year** of surgery and EKG is valid **within 6 months** of surgery. Diabetic patients need an EKG **within 3 months** of surgery.
- Diagnostic polysomnography report needed for patients with diagnosis of or symptoms suggestive of OSA.
- Interrogation studies (**within 3 months** of surgery) needed for patients with ICD and PPM.
- Patients with more complex medical conditions may require further work up (i.e. Stress test, Echocardiogram, Cardio/Pulmonary consult, etc). Please consult with anesthesiology department or patient's PCP.

Anesthesia Alerts: Patients with any of the following conditions requires surgeons to consult with anesthesiologist.

- AICD, pacemakers, insulin pump
- BMI > 40 and or Sleep Apnea (**BMI >45 are not appropriate for surgery at MEETH**)
- History of difficult intubation, CHF or recent EF <35%
- Radiation treatments to head and neck
